



## ***Myxomatosis kills rabbits.***

All breeds of rabbit are susceptible - even pets kept permanently inside your home can be exposed to the disease.

This is because myxomatosis is transmitted by blood-sucking insects such as fleas and mosquitoes. It is almost impossible to prevent a rabbit from coming into contact with these insects. So it is vital that you protect your pet using a vaccine as well as insect control.

A myxomatosis vaccine is available from your veterinary surgeon. This vaccine offers your rabbit the best available chance of immunity.
